How to enroll patients to the Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) Program

Remote Patient Monitoring is a free at-home monitoring program available to eligible patients. Patients receive education and monitoring while providing their health data remotely.

This innovative program was established to help patients improve their quality of life by providing education and monitoring. The goal is to improve self-management, and prevent repeat flare-ups that often lead to emergency department visits and hospital readmissions.

Who meets the criteria for the RPM Program?

- A clinical diagnosis of:
 - Heart Failure (HF)
 - Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
 - Diabetes Type II
 - COVID-19

- Age greater than or equal to 18 years
- Connectivity:
 - WiFi Internet in home
 - Cellular service capability
 Region:
 - Eastern Health
 - Labrador Grenfell Health
 - Central Health
 - Western Health
