USING PPE HELPS TO PROTECT YOU AND OTHERS

HAND HYGIENE

Special care must be paid to **hand hygiene** as it is the best way to prevent the spread of germs. **Good hand hygiene includes these steps**:

ALCOHOL-BASED HAND RUB

- · Apply to palm of one hand
- · Rub hands together, covering all of hands and fingers
- Rub until hands feel dry
- If hands are visibly dirty you must wash them before using Alcohol Based Hand Rub

HAND WASHING

- Use warm running water and soap
- Spend at least 15-30 seconds lathering and washing hands
- Rub hands together, paying attention to finger tips, around rings and thumbs
- Rinse thoroughly
- Dry with paper towel and turn off tap with paper towel
- Dispose of paper towel in the garbage







HANDS

 clean your hands with hand sanitizer or soap and water

EYE PROTECTION

 remove eye protection by handles and place in reprocessing bin or garbage



MASK/ N95 RESPIRATOR

- remove using loops or ties; do not touch mask.
- N95 should be removed outside of the room after the door has been closed. Place in garbage



6 HANDS

Clean your hands immediately after removal of PPE or anytime you suspect your hands are contaminated during PPE
