Collecting a Sputum Sample

Collection Container	•	If your doctor did not give you a bottle, go to the blood collection lab and get a sterile bottle.	
Collecting The sputum sample	•	Collect the sample in the morning when you get up and before you eat breakfast. Do not use mouthwash or gargle before you collect the sample. Cough deeply and then spit the sample into the bottle. The sample should be thick and contain mucous – not saliva (spit)	
Handling the Sample			
	•	Take the sample to the lab within 2 hours. If the sample cannot be taken to the lab right away, place it into a plastic baggie and put it in the refrigerator.
