






% Clients in receipt of home support services with a documented support plan in place


% Length of stay / expected length of stay in days




% Variance in resumption of services for COVID-19 alert level






% Variance in high-use physician biochemistry testing in comparison to peers




Daily doses of opioids² dispensed from community pharmacies within 72 hours following discharge for surgical procedures²


Estimated saving resulting from reduced energy consumption (kWh)
