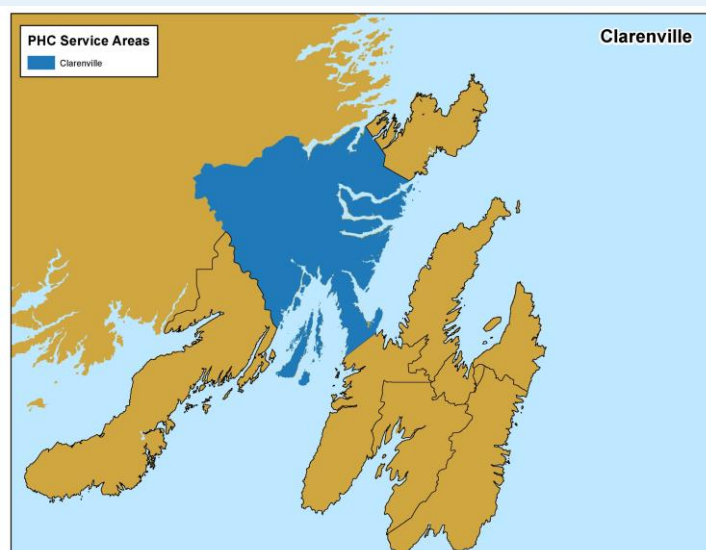

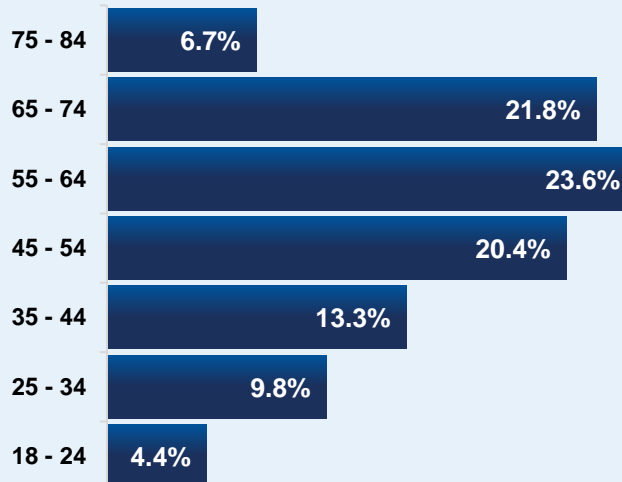

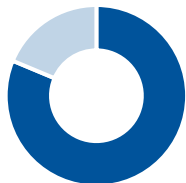

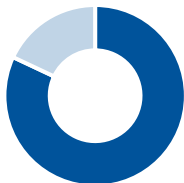

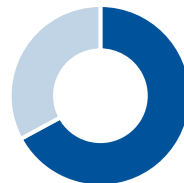

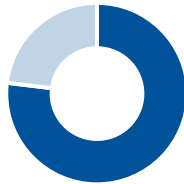

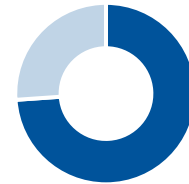
Physical Health
